- Average weight of a dolly: 35lbs./15.8kg
- Round-cornered, structural-grade anodized aluminum
- Superior balance and ergonomic handle design make for easy pulling
- Glass-reinforced, UV-protected, through-bolted plastic joint components
- Simplified design for fast assembly
- Three-inch wide, non-stretch sling for best the storage and easy retrieval in wavy conditions
- Easily broken down at splice joint and T-joint for quick trunk storage
- Tubeless ATV knobby tread tires with low friction Delrin needle bearings roll easily on all surfaces.

DOLLY TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS

Seitech dollies are beautifully engineered and crafted. Perfectly balanced, light-weight designs with low-friction wheel bearings make moving and launching a breeze. Whether you are a child launching an Optimist, an athlete preparing your C420 or Laser for a regatta, or an older adult launching your kayak or aluminum boat, there is a design to fit your needs. Perfectly. Each one is carefully engineered down to the smallest detail to give you many years of smooth, trouble-free service.



CONFIGURATION 1

Standard dolly for most boats under 250 pounds such as the Pico, International 470, Hunter 90, Escape 1, Club Flying Junior, small aluminum boats and small inflatables.



CONFIGURATION 2

Same shape as configuration 1 but has a special bow support and gunwale supports to fit boats like a Laser and a Byte.



CONFIGURATION 3

Same shape as configuration 1 but has a different bow support than configuration 2, fits boats like the Sabot and the Bug.



CONFIGURATION 4

Same shape as configuration 1 but has a different bow support than configuration 2, fits boats like the Sunfish, Zuma, Laser 2, Megabyte, Vanguard 15, JY15, and 29er.



CONFIGURATION 5

Same shape as configuration 1 but it has a double centerline (tongue) tube for boats over 250 pounds, like the Club 420, 49er, MC Scow, large inflatables and large aluminum boats.



CONFIGURATION 6

This dolly has no sling and is used for flat bottom boats under 150 pounds, like the Optimist and Pram.



CONFIGURATION 7

This dolly fits boats up to 250 pounds that have a vertical bow like the Finn, Snipe, Club 420, Europe and Escape.



CONFIGURATION 9

This dolly is for boats over 350 pounds with a standard flared bow. It has a double centerline tube and two axles (4 wheels) for added support especially needed for larger boats with motors. This supports boats such as a Hunter 170, Boston Whaler, Beetle Cat and larger inflatables.



CONFIGURATION 10

This dolly is for flat-bottom boats.



CONFIGURATION 14

This dolly shape has the standard configuration but with high bunks and no sling. It is used when the normal axle width is too wide to fit narrow docks or passages.



CONFIGURATION 15

This is a standard catamaran dolly. It has no sling or bunks. The wheels sit on the inside of the hulls.

SINGLE TREE RACK

- Used for kayaks, canoes or other boats with up to a 3ft beam
- Can be wall mounted
- Boats can be loaded from the side or the ends
- Limited space requirements



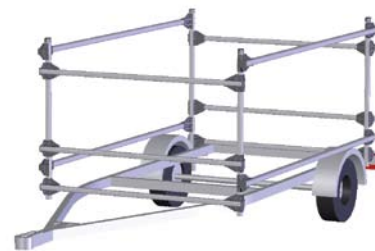
DOUBLE TREE RACKS

- Used for kayaks, canoes or other boats with up to a 3ft beam.
- Free-standing rack.
- Easily moved if on casters.
- Can load boats from the sides or ends.



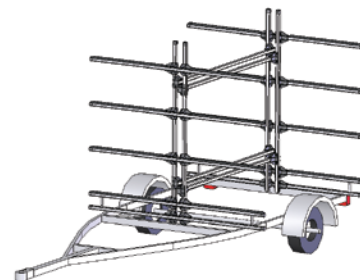
BOX RACKS

- Can hold any type of small boat up to 400 pounds with a maximum beam of 7 ft.
- Boats are loaded from the ends and stored deck side down.
- Can be mounted on casters for easy movement.
- Bunk rails can be added to allow boat to slide easily into the berth.
- Modular design can be added to later.



BOX TRAILER RACKS

- Designed to transport boats on the road.
- Can be built to fit different types of boats on the same trailer.
- Rack can be built over a larger boat that is supported directly on the trailer– this is especially useful in transporting sailboats along with a coach’s boat.
- Racks can be built with separate spar storage.
